In this position you will:

- Update and maintain Town's transparency platform. Monitor and develop monthly reports of revenues and expenditures for internal and external financial reports.
- Review booked permit revenues; coordinate with the Town departments and other members of the Finance department in maintaining accurate and ongoing accounting of permit activity.
- Assist in audit preparation by developing required schedules and reconciliation reports, and other data as required in the Town's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR).
- Maintain capital asset listing, review, and verify proper capital asset classification in Town's financial system. Facilitate annual capital asset inventory. Prepare year-end depreciation entries and capital asset schedules and notes for ACFR.
- Complete various specialized finance project involving independent research and financial data analysis.
- Review the Town's general ledger, accounts receivables, accounts payable, and payroll files for accuracy; serve as support and backup for other staff in the Finance department as needed.

Needs to have/be:

- Bachelor's Degree in Accounting with a minimum of one (1) year of experience in centralized accounting. Previous experience providing governmental accounting and fiscal management services in public agency setting preferred.
- Skilled in the use of personal computers and Microsoft software, (including advanced Excel skills)
- Ability to communicate in a clear and concise manner. Demonstrate a positive and professional demeanor at all times.
- The successful candidate must have the ability to pass a pre-employment background screening.
- Working knowledge of generally accepted principles and practices of accounting and auditing, and their application to governmental accounting systems; ability to analyze, understand and interpret financial reports.
