
As the Director you will plan, direct, manage and oversee the activities and operations of the Finance Department of 10 employees including accounting, revenue administration, treasury management, procurement, financial planning and budgeting; reporting to the City Manager.

The Director has full management responsibility for all Finance Department services and activities including revenue collections, operational & capital budgets, forecasting, debt service, financial statement preparation, the maintenance of central accounting systems, accounting controls, and administration of policies and procedures.

You will monitor and evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of service delivery methods and procedures; assess and monitor work load, administrative and support systems, and internal reporting relationships; identify opportunities for improvement; direct the implementation of changes.

Applicants must have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited university or college with major course work in accounting, finance, business administration or related field and minimum four years of increasingly responsible experience in governmental accounting and financial administration and oversight with at least three years of administrative and supervisory responsibility.

CPA or GFOA Certified Public Finance Officer preferred.





THE ORGANIZATION

The City of Sedona is a general law city, which operates under the Council-Manager form of government with six Council Members and one elected Mayor. The Council appoints the City Manager, who is responsible for carrying out policy enacted by the Council, and overseeing administration of the City.

Sedona currently has a staff of approximately 165 regular employees; City departments include the City Manager, City Attorney, City Clerk, Community Development, Economic Development, Public Works, Finance, Human Resources, Information Technology, Magistrate Court, Parks and Recreation, Police, Sustainability, and Wastewater.

The City enjoys a high degree of public involvement and collaboration on its boards, commissions, and advisory groups within the City. Citizens are active and engaged in Sedona's civic life.

The City has no property tax and relies on sales tax and lodging tax revenues to support its operations.

THE COMMUNITY

Sedona is approximately one and a half hours north of Phoenix in Yavapai and Coconino Counties and serves as a premier international tourist center.

Sedona was named after Sedona Miller Schnebly (1877–1950), who was celebrated for her hospitality and industriousness. Sedona's main attraction is its array of red sandstone formations. Originally founded in 1902, the City was incorporated in 1988 and is one of the premier tourism, recreation, retirement, art centers, with nearby viticulture .

Located in the high southwestern desert under the rim of the Colorado Plateau at an elevation of 4,500 feet, Sedona is blessed with four mild seasons and plenty of sunshine and clean air. The year round population of Sedona is approximately 9,000 residents, while the seasonal/visitor population often doubles that number on a regular basis. The City is almost 19 square miles in size, with 51% being owned by private landowners and the rest belonging to the Coconino National Forest.

The salary for the Director of Financial Services range is \$129,417 to \$176,280 annually.
